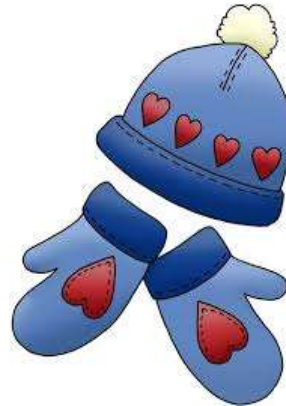

NEW STUDENT REGISTRATION (For Siblings Only) - If you have a child who will be newly entering St. Gregory the Great Academy in September, 2018, please call the school office so that an application package can be prepared. Packages will be sent home with a sibling later in January. The forms should be completed with all necessary documentation attached and returned to school on or before Friday, February 16th. You may send them to school with an older child or bring the completed forms to school yourself.
