

## One-Time or Casual COVID-19 Exposure Timelines

At all times, a symptomatic or exposed person who is waiting for COVID-19 test results is considered positive until a PCR test result proves that he or she is negative.

Individuals who are vaccinated **may avoid exclusion entirely** by having a PCR COVID-19 test performed on **Day 3 or Day 4** after exposure. Vaccinated individuals who choose **NOT** to have a PCR COVID-19 performed on Day 3 or Day 4 after exposure **will be excluded from Day 5 – Day 10**. **Positive test results will lead to immediate exclusion.**

Individuals who are **NOT** vaccinated **may return on any day, Day 7-10**, by having a PCR COVID-19 test performed on **Day 5 or later** after exposure and **submitting a negative result**. Nonvaccinated individuals who choose **NOT** to have a PCR COVID-19 performed on Day 5 or later after exposure **will be excluded from Day 1 – Day 10**.
